October Respect Life Month Knights of Peter Claver, Inc. October 2023 Activities

- 1. The first Sunday of October is generally observed as *Respect Life Sunday*. On this Sunday, sponsor workshops/seminars on Pro-life Issues or conduct a Service Project, which highlights the dignity of each person, the gift of human life and the responsibility to protect human life and/or schedule a Pro-Life Rosary utilizing the information from the USCCB, Pro-Life Rosaries. - 2. Individually You Can Join Catholics nationwide to praying a special Respect Life Month novena October 13th through the 21st. This novena prays for the protection of human life, from conception to natural death. Each day of the novena features a different pro-life prayer intention which is accompanied by a short reflection and suggested actions to help build a culture of life. Visit the following website:

Pro-Life Rosary Prayer Intentions

The Joyful Mysteries

The Annunciation: For parents facing an unexpected pregnancy, that they lovingly accept the precious life God has entrusted to their care.

The Visitation: That the family and friends of expectant parents might reach out and support them as they prepare to meet their child face to face.

The Nativity: That the love of the Blessed Mother and the Christ Child may be a source of strength for every expectant mother, especially mothers living in poverty, and that they both will be surrounded by joy and love.

The Presentation: That fathers of young children will model St. Joseph in devoutly practicing their faith, so that they lead their children to God by their words and example.

The Finding of Jesus in the Temple: For all children who have been lost and forgotten, that they may be led to a place where they are treasured, protected and loved.

The Luminous Mysteries

The Baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan: That all baptized Christians will be open to the Holy Spirit and bear witness to the sanctity of life.

The Wedding Feast at Cana: For all husbands and wives, that they treasure the priceless gift of married love by generously accepting children through procreation and adoption.

The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God: That those who pray and work for greater respect for human life will be guided by the Beatitudes and reveal the face of Christ to others.

The Transfiguration: That our world will be transfigured by the witness of faithful Christians so that all may understand the priceless value of every human being.

The Institution of the Eucharist: That through our worthy reception of the Eucharist and frequent Eucharistic Adoration, Jesus will teach us to love sacrificially the least and neediest among us.

The Sorrowful Mysteries

The Agony in the Garden: For all who are suffering from abandonment or neglect, that compassionate individuals will come forward to offer them comfort and aid.

The Scourging at the Pillar: That the victims of violence, torture and slavery will be delivered from their suffering, find healing and know that God is close to them.

The Crowning with Thorns: That the persecution of Christians will end in a new era of tolerance and respect for the religious freedom and conscience rights of all.

The Carrying of the Cross: For all who labor under burdens that seem too great to bear—due to illness, age, poverty, cruelty or injustice—that our prayers and aid will lighten their crosses.

The Crucifixion: For an end to the death penalty and for the release of all prisoners of conscience and all who have been wrongfully convicted.

The Glorious Mysteries

The Resurrection: For all who have lost loved ones, and especially for parents of a child who was miscarried, aborted or stillborn, that they will find peace in the promise of the Resurrection.

The Ascension: For all who struggle with addictions, that through Christ's triumph and ascent into glory, they may triumph over their temptations, and gain strength and peace.

The Coming of the Holy Spirit: That the Holy Spirit will open the minds and hearts of those who now reject the Gospel of Life and allow them to be convinced of the truth and goodness of all that the Church professes concerning human life.

The Assumption of Mary: For mothers who have died at the hands of abortion providers, that they may experience reconciliation and together with their children know God's peace.

The Coronation of Mary: For all mothers, that they might come to know the wonder of their vocation.

That the life of every person, from conception to natural death, will be protected in our laws and cherished in our hearts; We pray to the Lord:


Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

A Rosary for Life: The Joyful Mysteries

The following meditations on the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary are offered as a prayer for all life, from conception to natural death.

The First Joyful Mystery - The Annunciation of Our Lord

Prayer Intention: For parents facing an unexpected pregnancy, that they lovingly accept the precious life God has entrusted to their care.

The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary. And coming to her, he said, "Hail, favored one! The Lord is with you." But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her. (Luke 1:26-33, 38)

As an angel proclaimed the conception of Christ in Mary's virginal womb, so do mothers and fathers learn every day of the conception of their child. Let us pray to the Mother of all the Living that every child be treasured and protected from the first moment of conception as an inestimable and wondrous gift of God.

The Second Joyful Mystery - The Visitation

Prayer Intention: That the family and friends of expectant parents might reach out and support them as they prepare to meet their child face to face.

During those days Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth. When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the infant leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the holy Spirit, cried out in a loud voice and said, "Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb. And how does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? For at the moment the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the infant in my womb leaped for joy. Blessed are you who believed that what was spoken to you by the Lord would be fulfilled." (Luke 1:39-45)

As the child in Elizabeth's womb leaped for joy when the Blessed Virgin, pregnant with the Son of God, came to meet her, so may our hearts leap with joy at the wonders of new life promised in every expectant mother.

The Third Joyful Mystery - The Nativity of Jesus

Prayer Intention: That the love of the Blessed Mother and the Christ Child may be a source of strength for every expectant mother, especially mothers living in poverty, and that they both will be surrounded by joy and love.

While they were there, the time came for her to have her child, and she gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him in swaddling clothes and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. Now there were shepherds in that region living in the fields and keeping the night watch over their flock. The angel of the Lord appeared to them and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were struck with great fear. The angel said to them, "Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find an infant wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger." (Luke 2: 6-12)

In the birth of every child we see the birth of Christ Jesus in the Bethlehem stable. Let us commend all new mothers and fathers and every newborn child to the protection and intercession of the Mother of God and Mother of all Christians.

Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose name was Simeon. This man was righteous and devout, awaiting the consolation of Israel, and the holy Spirit was upon him. It had been revealed to him by the holy Spirit that he should not see death before he had seen the Messiah of the Lord. He came in the Spirit into the temple; and when the parents brought in the child Jesus to perform the custom of the law in regard to him, he took him into his arms and blessed God, saying: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in sight of all the peoples, a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." (Luke 2:25-32)

As Christ was consecrated to God at his presentation in the temple, so may we consecrate all children to that holiness, purity, and innocence by which they lead us to God. "A little child shall lead them."

The Fifth Joyful Mystery - The Finding in the Temple

Prayer Intention: For all children who have been lost and forgotten, that they may be led to a place where they are treasured, protected and loved.

Each year his parents went to Jerusalem for the feast of Passover, and when he was twelve years old, they went up according to festival custom. After they had completed its days, as they were returning, the boy Jesus remained behind in Jerusalem, but his parents did not know it. Thinking that he was in the caravan, they journeyed for a day and looked for him among their relatives and acquaintances, but not finding him, they returned to Jerusalem to look for him. After three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers. When his parents saw him, they were astonished, and his mother said to him, "Son, why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been looking for you with great anxiety." And he said to them, "Why were you looking for me? Did you not know that I must be in my Father's house?" But they did not understand what he said to them. (Luke 2:41-50)

As the Christ Child was found in the temple by the Blessed Virgin Mary and Saint Joseph, so we pray for all children, especially those lost and forgotten. The Finding of Jesus in the Temple: For all children who have been lost and forgotten, that they may be led to a place where they are treasured, protected and loved.

The Luminous Mysteries

The Baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan: That all baptized Christians will be open to the Holy Spirit and bear witness to the sanctity of life.

The Wedding Feast at Cana: For all husbands and wives, that they treasure the priceless gift of married love by generously accepting children through procreation and adoption.

The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God: That those who pray and work for greater respect for human life will be guided by the Beatitudes and reveal the face of Christ to others.

The Transfiguration: That our world will be transfigured by the witness of faithful Christians so that all may understand the priceless value of every human being.

The Institution of the Eucharist: That through our worthy reception of the Eucharist and frequent Eucharistic Adoration, Jesus will teach us to love sacrificially the least and neediest among us.

The Sorrowful Mysteries

The Agony in the Garden: For all who are suffering from abandonment or neglect, that compassionate individuals will come forward to offer them comfort and aid.

The Scourging at the Pillar: That the victims of violence, torture and slavery will be delivered from their suffering, find healing and know that God is close to them.

The Crowning with Thorns: That the persecution of Christians will end in a new era of tolerance and respect for the religious freedom and conscience rights of all.

The Carrying of the Cross: For all who labor under burdens that seem too great to bear—due to illness, age, poverty, cruelty or injustice—that our prayers and aid will lighten their crosses.

The Crucifixion: For an end to the death penalty and for the release of all prisoners of conscience and all who have been wrongfully convicted.

The Glorious Mysteries

The Resurrection: For all who have lost loved ones, and especially for parents of a child who was miscarried, aborted or stillborn, that they will find peace in the promise of the Resurrection.

The Ascension: For all who struggle with addictions, that through Christ's triumph and ascent into glory, they may triumph over their temptations, and gain strength and peace.

The Coming of the Holy Spirit: That the Holy Spirit will open the minds and hearts of those who now reject the Gospel of Life and allow them to be convinced of the truth and goodness of all that the Church professes concerning human life.

The Assumption of Mary: For mothers who have died at the hands of abortion providers, that they may experience reconciliation and together with their children know God's peace.

The Coronation of Mary:

For all mothers, that they might come to know the wonder of their vocation.

PRAYER FOR RADICAL SOLIDARITY

O Blessed Mother, at the angel's word you went in haste to the aid of your cousin Elizabeth. Although pregnant yourself, you placed her needs before your own.

By your example of radical solidarity, teach us to reverence and protect those in need, without conditions or expectations. Ask your Son to give us unfailing determination to witness to the profound dignity of every person, at every stage and in every circumstance.

In that first Eucharistic procession, you carried Jesus to Elizabeth in her time of need. Obtain for us the grace to bring Christ to any expectant mother who is alone and afraid.

May our support help them to find hope and strength in the Lord. Amen.

Pro-Life Activities National Committee 2023

The following recommendations are based upon the discussion held on Wednesday, June 28, 2023:

- 1. There is a need to define and have a clear definition of Pro-Life Issues. We recommend members attend educational opportunities which iterate that Pro-Life is not one single issue. It is imperative that we become aware of critical issues which involve threats to human life and dignity and relate these issues to Catholic Social Teaching. Pro-Life encompasses a multitude of life and death Issues. These issues include but are not limited to: Abortion, Racism, Capital Punishment, Mass Incarceration, Prison Reform, Crisis Pregnancy/Adoption, Bioethics/Ethical Stem Cell Research, Euthanasia End of Life Issues, Environment, Health Care and Health Disparities, Cloning, Human Trafficking and Pornography, Issues which affect Family Life, Violence and all forms of Abuse and Neglect, Immigration Reform, Poverty, Unjust Wars, Legislation and Public Policies that affect Christian Principles.
- 2. The Knights of Peter Claver, Incorporated continue to focus on education and participation regarding pro-life issues.
- 3. The committee recommends that Prison Reform, Capital Punishment, and Mass Incarceration be prioritized for the coming year. Courts and Councils, we are called to become involved in Prison Ministry Programs and advocate for Prison Reform.
- 4. The Respect for Life Mass which has been held since 2013 on the Monday of convention is designated as such for all future senior national conventions.
- 5. The National Office continue to utilize the Pro-Life Respect Live Banner at each national convention and provide educational materials on Pro-Life/Respect Life issues received only from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) for consistency throughout our Noble Order.
- 6. The committee recommends the appointment of District Pro-Life Coordinators and the appointment of Pro-life Coordinator in each Court/Council. The District Pro-Life Coordinators would act as a main point of contact and assist in organizing and implementing the recommendation from the National Pro-Life Activities Committee. The Court/Council Pro-Life coordinator will implement pro-life activities within their respect communities.
- 7. The committee recommends utilizing the *Respect Life 30*-day prayer/reflection created by the National Pro-Life Activities Committee (2015). The calendar should be sent to the Councils and Courts for use as an awareness of pro-life/respect for life, especially during

the month of October.

- 8. Courts and Councils implement the Prayer for Life as part of their Opening Prayer.
- 9. Courts implement the nationwide effort, Walking with Moms in Need Program to increase the Church's outreach to pregnant and parenting women in need. An Action guide for the program is founded on the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) website: https://www.respectlife.org/respect-life-month. Through Walking with Moms in Need, vulnerable women find support in welcoming and caring for their children.
- The committee recommends that each Council and Court conduct with its members a
 Pro-Life training class. The Training materials should be placed on the Knights of Peter
 Claver web site <u>Knights of Peter Claver (kofpc.org)</u>
- 11. The committee recommends that the KPC National Office consolidate the Pro-Life training material, National Social Justice Initiatives Resource Book, and the 30-day Respect Life Prayer and Reflection Calendar, found on the Knights of Peter Claver website, into one file to allow for easy access.
- 12. The committee recommends during the month of October, each Council and Court celebrate Respect Life Month, by utilizing the material from the USCCB website and each meeting during the month of October use the Prayer for the protection of human life at the beginning of meetings.
- 13. The committee recommends during the month of October, the first Sunday of October is generally observed as *Respect Life Sunday*. On this Sunday, sponsor workshops/seminars on Pro-life Issues or conduct a Service Project, which highlights the dignity of each person, the gift of human life and the responsibility to protect human life.
